Learner registration fees 27-03-2026

The Learner registration regional fee applied to a Centre's location is determined at the time of Learner registration.

Following payment of the registration fee, each learner will be allocated:

- An individual assessment area on the AA platform that enables upload of completed assessment documents
- Access to syllabus, marking rubrics and guidance on how to complete the assessments for the qualification the learner is registered against
- Access to practice examinations (where included in the assessment)

Learner assessment fees include online access to all assessments for a module for a Learner. Assessments will be time and date limited according to the Advance Assessments examination schedule. The schedule for a Learner's cohort is published in each Learners individual log-in to the platform. Following successful assessment, each learner will be awarded:

- A digital certificate that can be verified on the AA platform.
